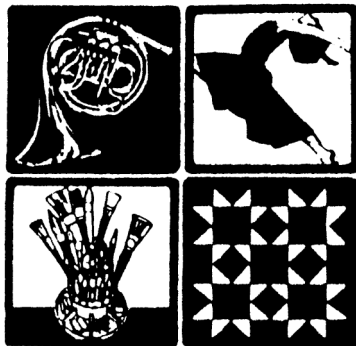

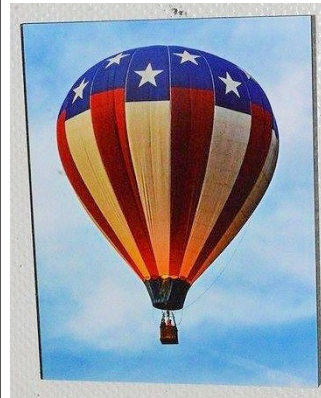
The WAA will celebrate 70 years of bringing wonderful art to Allegany County residents during 2018!

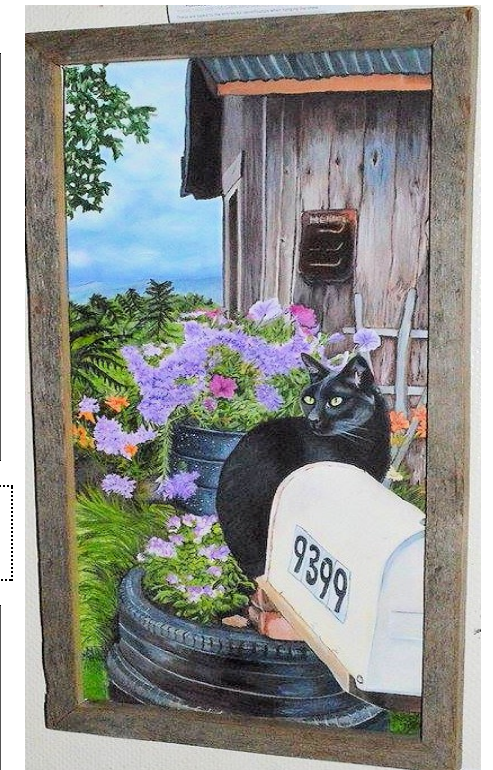

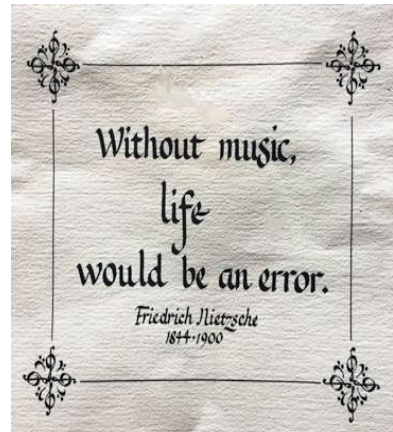
